A RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City of Westwego, or the Parish of Jefferson, Louisiana, in a public meeting held on Monday, May 13, 2019, which meeting was conducted in accordance with the Open Meetings Law and the additional requirements of Article VII, Section 23(C) of the Louisiana Constitution and R.S. 47:1705(B), that the following millage rates be and are hereby levied upon the dollar of the assessed valuation of all property subject to ad valorem taxation within said City for the year 2018, for the purpose of raising revenue:
