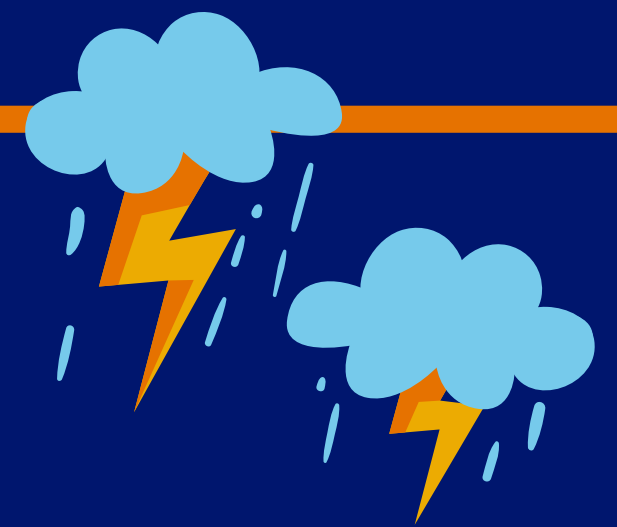


Emergency Supply Kit Checklist



- Water (1 gallon per person per day for 3-7 days)
- Non-perishable food for at least 3-7 days
- Multi-tool and manual can opener
- Battery-operated AM/FM radio or NOAA weather radio
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- First Aid Kit - include prescription medications
- Personal hygiene products
- Fully charged mobile phone
- Important documents (should be kept in a waterproof, portable container)
 - Medical records
 - Insurance policies
 - Identification (ID, passport, etc.)
 - Social security card
 - Proof of residence
 - Birth and/or marriage certificates
 - Bank account numbers
 - Set of car, house keys
- Propane tanks and gas cans
- Battery powered phone charger
- Special items and food for:
 - Infants/small children or elderly/disabled
- Clothing and bedding
- Games, activities, books
- Extra cash
- Garbage bags, moist towelettes and cleaning products
- Fire extinguisher
- Whistle to signal for help
- Pet care items
- Mess kits, paper cups, plates and plastic utensils, paper towels
